The application and all supporting materials must be returned by Friday, May 21, 2021 at 5:00 p.m. to be considered.

The Chief Joseph Buenrostro Scholarships are awarded in memory of the former Chief of the West Chicago Police Department. Chief Buenrostro was a strong supporter of education and youth programs. He served as president of the DuPage County Chiefs of Police Association in 1967. Applicants must maintain full-time student status for the full term of the school year.

- Submit a letter of recommendation from their High School Principal, Counselor, or College Department Head
- Provide proof of being accepted at or attending an accredited college or university

Application Instructions

Eligibility for this scholarship is limited to children of full-time police officers (active duty at time of application) serving in a DuPage County agency. Applicants must attend a regionally accredited 2 or 4-year College or University. Applicants must maintain full time student status (12 credit hours minimum) for the full terms of the 2021/2022 school year. Three scholarships are available. The scholarship amount is \$1000 (\$500 per semester).

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Type or print clearly.
2. Attach a cover letter describing your reasons for applying for this scholarship including financial need, any community service you have performed, any leadership positions that you have held and your future plans for college and beyond.
3. Attach a 2-page double spaced essay in one of the recognized accepted formats of **APA, MLA, or CHICAGO/TURABIAN**, on the below topic:

Describe how you have demonstrated your leadership ability both in and out of school.

4. Attach a letter or other proof of your acceptance by the College or University you plan to attend or a copy of the class schedule of the college you are already attending.
5. Attach a letter of recommendation from your High School Principal, Counselor, or College Department Head.
6. **Applications must be received no later than 5:00 PM, Friday, May 21, 2021 to be considered.**
